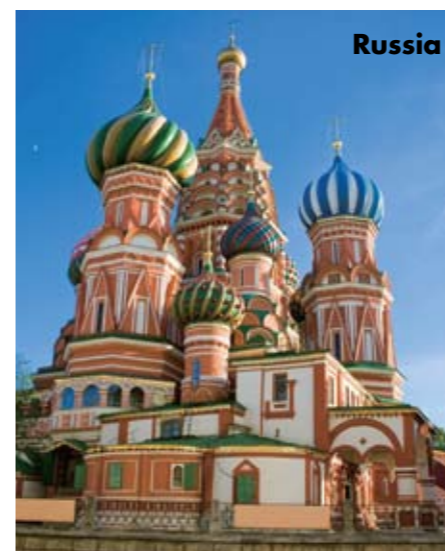
Great Escapes

Summer time and the living is easy, as soulful Nina Simone once sang, but, as anyone whose sweltered through a Shanghai summer will tell you, the city's 20 million people and towering monolithic skyscrapers turn the downtown of Shanghai into an urban oven. Residents of Shanghai Centre wishing to escape the all encompassing humidity are in luck, however, as right on their very doorstep are some experts in the field of travel. Here to give us the lowdown on their respective countries are some of the airlines located in the Shanghai Centre.

To Russia With Love

To the north of China is Russia, the great and, to some extent mysterious, landmass that spans two continents. Yuri Guqin, General Manager of Aeroflot Russian Airlines, the Russian national carrier, enthusiastically states his case for his home country. Russia has a long and colourful past, from Tsarist Russia through to the Communist period, and has always written its history large on the world stage, and, says Guqin, "the World Heritage List has 23 historical monuments which are situated in Russia." Moscow, the country's capital, has perhaps some of the most iconic, such as the Red Square, one of the most famous city squares in the world. Opposite this is The Kremlin, the former palace of Russian royalty and now residence of the Russian President, and St. Basil's Cathedral, whose beautiful striped, onion-shaped domes make it one of the most distinctive buildings in the world.

Away from the cities, the endless steppes popularized in Russia literature are breathtaking, but Guqin reminds not to leave without sampling

some of the country's traditional fare. "There will be pirozhki (savory Russian pies that are often filled with beef and onion)," reminisces Guqin, "and syrniki (a sort of cheese pancake served with a sweet condiment)." He also recommends that visitors from China sample the Russian version of a dumpling called a pelmeni, which is usually stuffed with meat and vegetables and seasoned with black pepper and onion.

Visitors to Russia on May 9 can experience 'Victory Day', when the entire country celebrates the victory over Nazi Germany in WWII through numerous military parades. Aside from the bombastic celebrations, May and June are particularly good times to visit Russia, as the country, often viewed as being in a perpetual winter, has particularly hot and sunny weather at this time.

Now to Japan

Closer to home, geographically and culturally, is Japan and Wu Yi, Passenger Sales Manger at the

Nippon Airways Office in Shanghai Centre was keen to pitch her country. "Japan is not far from Shanghai, only about three hour's flight time," she says, noting that Japanese culture and fashion are very influential in Shanghai and China as a whole. She would recommend visitors to go to the northern island of Hokkaido, saying "It is a beautiful place. You can go skiing and bathe in hot springs in winter and go on a lavender tour in summer." The island is famous for its flowers and the months of May and June sees Hokkaido's hills and fields carpeted in purple lavender flowers.

In Wu Yi's opinion, Japan's most attractive qualities are the natural beauty of its scenery and the quality and taste of its food, because, as she says, "you can enjoy both with your eyes and your mouth." Japan's cuisine is legendary, with Tokyo surpassing Paris last year in terms of three-starred Michelin restaurants, and the range of options from sashimi and sushi, through to teppanyaki and yakitori, are as diverse as they are delicious. The seafood in

particular, unsurprisingly perhaps given Japan is an island, is especially fine although the prices do tend to reflect this.

Residents of Shanghai Centre can get tourist information and experience the renowned Japanese customer service at the counter of the Nippon Airways Office. The airline is offering a summer promotion called HAYAWARI 21 from 15 May to 30 June 2009, where, if you buy the ticket 21 days before departure, you receive a prize. In addition, a roundtrip economy ticket to Tokyo is CNY 3,500, to Nagoya is CNY 2,500, and to Osaka is CNY 2,300, plus tax.

Turkish Delight

The bridge between Europe and Asia, East and West, Turkey has captivated hearts and imaginations since the time of the Ottoman Empire. The General Manger of Turkish Airlines, Shanghai Office, Gayret Yüksel, believes that it is this distinct identity in culture, architecture and history that makes Turkey a fascinating place to visit.

May and June are particularly pleasant times, with warm weather and sea breezes coming off both the Mediterranean and Aegean Seas. Turkey, says Yüksel, and the beaches on the Mediterranean coastline are a particularly popular destination for honeymooners. For those in search of a more cultural vacation though, Istanbul, one of the world's great historical cities, has some wonderful places of interest. Highlights include the Tokapi Palace of the Ottoman Sultans and the Sultan Ahmet Mosque, also known as the Blue Mosque for the blue tiles that adorn the interior.

Turkey's cuisine is, just like the country, a product of Asian, Middle Eastern and European cultures. Yüksel insists that travellers in Turkey try some of the eponymous coffees, served sweet or bitter, and the decadently sweet, Turkish delight. The most common meat is lamb, although visitors who think that this ends at döner kebabs, risk missing out on the range of delicious grilled meats served nationwide.

Turkish Airlines is currently offering a package tour

for CNY 9,800 for eight days stay including tax and accommodation at a 4-star hotel. You will have to visit a travel agent or book online, however, as the office in Shanghai Centre does not handle tour groups but does do individual tickets and can provide information.

Tropical Philippines

Sometimes we just want to escape city life and Gerard O. Panga, Tourism Attaché at the Philippine Tourism Office in Shanghai Centre, believes that the Philippines, the closest tropical country destination to China, is just that. Panga estimates that four or five hours after leaving Shanghai, you can be "checked in already at a hotel, having a spa, or gearing up for a round of golf or shopping." This makes even a weekend city escape to the Philippines potentially doable, particularly given the good purchasing power visitors from China now with American Dollars and Chinese RMB having good exchange value against the Peso.

An archipelago of 7,107 islands, there are predictably a lot of choices, from beach holidays and island hopping adventures, to some of the world's best scuba diving sites. The white sands of Boracay's beautiful beaches are a popular destination for those looking to relax, while the more active can engage in water sports, golf, shopping, island tours, fishing, and bar hopping. Panga's inside tip for those seeking solitude is to head to the resorts on the tips of Boracay Island and recommends the newly opened and luxurious Shangri-la Boracay Resort.

The Philippines is an overwhelmingly Catholic country and the month of May is known as a fiesta month. Celebrations for town saints can be found all over the country, says Panga, and especially in Quezon Province for the Pahiyas festival where the town folks parade their agricultural goods on carts pulled by carabaos (large Filipino water-buffalo) accompanied by street parades and lavish eating and drinking. Colourful and beautiful as the islands are, Panga argues, and a survey conducted by the country's tourist board shows, that the warmth and friendliness of Filipino people is the most memorable part of a holiday here.

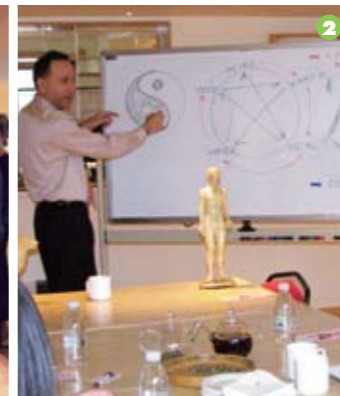
