# Al Fresco

## The Best of Shanghai Centre Outdoor Dining!

The term al fresco dates all the way back to an Italian 18th century expression meaning "out-of-doors; in the open air" -- or literally, "in a cool place." Clearly, the term reflects the fact that in 18th century Italy, a nice breeze was the closest thing to air conditioning that one could hope for, so it made sense to enjoy meals outside when the weather was nice. The concept of al fresco dining in China has a somewhat different history. Until recently, Chinese people confined their outdoor dining experiences to sipping tea on a balmy summer evening, or, for the common man (aka the lao bai xing), slurping noodles while sitting on a plastic stool at the local noodle stand.

But a lot's changed lately -- especially in Shanghai's blossoming culinary world. And Shanghai Centre was at the vanguard of that change, introducing local people to the concept of elegant outdoor dining and leisurely weekend brunches while bathing in

the (gasp!) sunshine. To this day, local ladies have yet to embrace the tradition of soaking up spring sunshine while sipping a cappuccino and reading the paper on a Sunday morning...unless sheltered by a large pair of Dior sunglasses and a good amount of Lancome SPF 50. But the outdoor dining part has certainly caught on -- and, well, thank goodness for parasols.

Now that spring has settled in, it's the perfect time to enjoy an al fresco meal. And, with so many new options opening recently at Shanghai Centre, there's never been a better time to enjoy a great meal under the clear blue skies or starry night.

In terms of bringing the concept of al fresco dining to Shanghai, you needn't look further than Element Fresh. Element founders Scott Minoie and Sheldon Habiger were among the earliest pioneers to bring café-style al fresco dining to Shanghai, back when Element opened its first location at Shanghai Centre in 2002. And it's managed to stay one of the hottest outdoor dining spots ever since, sparking the trend of al fresco dining at Shanghai Centre.

Recently, with favorable weather prevailing, I set out to enjoy as many meals as possible in the great outdoors of Shanghai Centre, starting with



brunch at Baker&Spice. The reason I decided to begin my journey there was that, for one, the patio at Baker&Spice, faces east, it was the best time of day to catch some direct sunlight. And secondly, I'm a big fan of both their coffee and their deliciously-fluffy, powdered-sugar-coated, chocolate-filled, almond-crust croissants! Just to say it is a mouth-full!

From there, it was an easy stroll over to Element Fresh. I've eaten at Element so often over the past few years that I know their entire menu by heart. But it's never a disappointment to kick back on one of their spacious bench seats and sip a large very berry smoothie while enjoying a laffa bread salad.

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There've been times while eating at Element that I've had to pinch myself and make sure I wasn't just dreaming of being back in Los Angeles – especially while sitting in front of their California Hippy sandwich.

But as the term al fresco is, for whatever reason, distinctly Italian (though it's hard to believe that other cultures hadn't discovered outdoor dining prior to the Italians), I decided to head over to the motherland, Pizza Marzano. With a view of the beautiful Xiao Nan Guo building, separated from Shanghai Centre by the tranquil Rose Garden, Pizza Marzano's patio scores high marks for its outdoor atmosphere. My lunch companion and I shared a generously-sized Margherita Prima pizza, plus a fresh rocket salad with a splash of tangy vinaigrette and shaved parmesan cheese. Paired with a tall bottle of San Pellegrino sparkling mineral water, it was almost like being transported to Naples. We toasted with a hearty buon appetito in the warm sunshine, humming the tune to "That's Amore!"

Dinner plans had to be put on hold, as by the end of that meal I couldn't possibly eat another thing all day. So I made a date with my friend Teddy Lee for lunch the next day at Din Tai Fung. Teddy is from Taiwan, and is what you might call a "xiao long bao connoisseur". We met around 1pm, just after the lunch rush when it's impossible to get a seat at Din Tai Fung. Teddy greeted me with a warm welcome and an astounding array of Din Tai Fung dishes as he explained the beauty and uniqueness of each one, from the black truffle & pork xiao long bao, to the mushroom & crab variety, as well as some delicious noodles with preserved vegetables and shredded pork. The outdoor seating area was small but cozy, and the weather couldn't have been more perfect, as the xiao long bao just kept on

coming, one wonderful flavor after the next.

Though tempted to carry on stuffing myself, I had to leave room for two more stops that day – Gourmet Café and Palladio. With its plush soft white sofas, large parasols and wicker chair motif, I have to say that Gourmet Café wins serious kudos for comfortable daytime Al Fresco dining. With a menu dominated by burgers, it seems more a daytime spot to me. Though I'm sure the nights here are just as enjoyable, as well. I boldly managed to down an El Beano veggie burger, a side of rosemary and thyme fries, and a blueberry milkshake! It was late afternoon by then, and still the sun felt warm and inviting as I stripped down to a t-shirt (and a bulging belly).

I thought I should end my journey back again with the Italians, honoring the Al Fresco theme, so just before nightfall I headed over to Palladio, which had just opened up a small but elegant outdoor dining area that will remain in operation until the end of the summer. This is true Al Fresco dining for fans of great Italian cuisine. Upscale food in a relaxed and romantic atmosphere – the very essence of what Al Fresco is all about. Everything, from the presentation to the service and the meal, itself, was spot-on. The sun disappeared and the candlelight flickered over a plate of three-meat stuffed Piedmont-style Agnolotti Ravioli with sage veal juice and black truffle, toasted with a glass of Pinot Noir.

My only regret was that Lapis Thai hadn't yet opened its doors in time for this article. With a tempting Thai-fusion menu and plans for an ultrachic spacious outdoor dining area, my reporter's instincts tell me that it is set to be the premiere al fresco spot in all of Shanghai Centre (I'm already a big fan of the gorgeous patio at their French Concession location). So look for part two of this article some time in the near future. In the meantime, hope you're enjoying this article while sitting outside in the warm sunshine with a cool breeze and a delicious meal in front of you. It might be French Toast or even xiao long bao, but, in some sense, we can all say we owe a big grazie to the Italians for the al fresco tradition. Buon Appetito!
